Executive Summary:

PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING Project's Master Plan has the construction of 108 ft. tall Indian Great Master Maguru Padmasambhava, Guru Rinpoche Statue including two story of 36 ft. high Community, Meditation and Teaching Hall, 14 ft. lotus seat, 58 ft. copper body is the main parts of the project. Beside this school building, hostel, garden and park, entrance gate, stupa, parking are the other feature of the project.

In this estimate:

1. The cost of 14 ft. lotus seat and 58 ft. copper statue cost of **NPR 180,000,000.00 in words: Eighteen Crores Rupees,**
2. The cost of civil work (concrete structure) of 52.5.ft. length, 42.5 ft. width and 36 ft. high two story community, meditation and teaching hall building which is the foundation or seat of the Guru Rinpoche Copper Statue estimated **NPR 75,784,193.02 in words: Seven Crore Fifty-Seven Lakhs Eighty-Four Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-Three Rupees and Two paisa** and
3. The cost of compound wall and entrance gate **NPR 43,759,006.31 in words: Four Crores Thirty Seven Lakhs Fifty Nine Thousand and Six Rupees and Thirty One Paisa.**

The total estimated cost to develop basic infrastructures is about **NPR 29,95,43,199.33 in words: Twenty-Nine Crores Ninety-Five Lakhs Forty Three Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-Nine Rupees and Thirty Three Paisa only/-**

It will be managed by national, international and internal donations and supports.

Total Project Land 22,850 sq.m. (44-14-2-2.28) (R-A-P-D) area approximate cost of NPR 36,000,000.00 in words: Three Crores Sixty Lakhs Rupees is already managed by Local Contribution.

Academic Block with Class Rooms, Kitchen and Dining Block, Hostel Block, Pilgrims residence blocks, stupa design and cost are not included here.

The project authorization letter was provided by local government of Solududkundha Municipality on 6 August 2025.

After completion of this Master Plan, thousands of Buddhist pilgrimages will visit here, alongside the visitors of Halesi Cave, Buddha's relics, peripheral monasteries, Dumji and Manirimdu festivals expected to visit here.

The trackers visiting Dudhkunda Lake, a sacred site for Hindus, Buddhists, and Kirants, viewpoints like Pattale Dada, Ratnage Dada and Pike Danda also will visit here.

PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING Project, is in the center of Solududhkunda Municipality-5 Sallery, Solukhumbu district headquarter. There is no other such big hall and facilities in this area, so the community peoples will organize celebration, Buddhist festivals, seminar, training, teaching and meditation.

It creates an architectural icon symbolizing divine harmony through the presence of Guru Rinpoche Statue which develops a spiritual and cultural landmark that attracts pilgrims, tourists, and seekers of peace. Promotes local economy and identity by encouraging local agriculture, hotels, crafts, guided tours, and hospitality services.

Introduction and Background:

Palyul Pema Tsokey Ling is non-profit organization registered in Company Registered Office, Tripureswor and Social Welfare Council, Lalitpur. It has a Master Plan of PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING, Solududhkunda Municipality-5, Sallery, Solukhumbu, Nepal. In the Preliminary Design Phase following components have been designed in 22,850 sq.m. (44-14-2-2.28) (R-A-P-D) area of organization land.

- Guru Rinpoche statue with community hall.
- Entrance Gate
- Parking area
- Garden

Additional components in the site for future provision:

- Academic Block with Class Rooms
- Kitchen and Dining Block
- Hostel Block
- Pilgrims residence blocks

Great Master Mahaguru Padmasambhava is deeply connected and venerated with all aspect of Mahayna and Vjrayana Buddhism. He has visited, meditated and taught Nalanda, Bihar; Tso-Pema (Riwalsar), Himachal; Zanskar (Dechen Dalwa), Ladhak; Odisha (some believe that he was originated from Odisha) and Sikkim before coming to Nepal, Tibet and Bhutan. He has visited, meditated and taught Pharping, Kathmandu, Mustang, Nuwakot, Makawanpur, Kavreplanchok, Sindhupalchok, Khotang and Sankhuwasabha districts in Nepal and many places of Tibet and Bhutan.

Padmasambhava said:

In Lake Danakosha, Padmasambhava;
Distinctively, I appear as three kayas;
In truth, there is no difference among them.
In Dharmakaya, I am Samantabdra.
In Akanishta, Vajradhara.

Solududhkunda Municipality is the pioneering municipality of Solukhumbu district. It was established on Mangsir 17, 2071 by merging VDCs: Salleri, Loding, Tamakhani, Gaarma, Beni, Takshindu, Kerung, Gorakhani, Taping, and Tingla. Solududhkunda Municipality's total population of 24,323 and an area of 565.06 square kilometers. The municipality is divided into 11 wards. Approximately more than 80% of the populations are Buddhist.

Solududhkunda Municipality in Solukhumbu District is the entry point of Everest region trekking, mountaineering expedition and national park offers diverse tourism opportunities, including natural beauty, spiritual sites, and cultural attractions of Dudhkunda Lake, a sacred site for Hindus, Buddhists, and Kirants, viewpoints like Pattale Dada, and Ratnage Dada. The municipality is also developing a 25-kilometer foot trail connecting Pike Danda to Dudhkunda, enhancing accessibility and tourism potential.

PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING Guru Rinpoche (Mahguru Padmasambhava)'s 108 copper statue is tallest statue in Nepal situated in the central point of Buddha's sacred holy relic in Pema Thegcholing Monastery, Sallery and the nearby sacred Halesi Cave in Khotang district whereas Guru Rinpoche received immortal achievement. Therefore, PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING project contribute Buddhist tourism circuit for the promotion of Buddhist culture, teachings, businesses; hotel, agriculture, transportation, guide etc.

Dumji and Mani Rimdu is a significant religious festival for the Sherpa people, deeply rooted in Buddhist teachings and traditions honoring Guru Rinpoche. It is also a major cultural event, bringing together the monastic community and local people. The festival is believed to bring blessings, purify the environment, and promote well-being.

The Padmasambhava's powerful image not only bless the environment but also contribute to the local economy and preserve ancient artisan techniques. "Building Guru Rinpoche statues will bring immeasurable benefit, peace, happiness, and freedom to the world.

Project Goal:

1. People will realize and experience a sense of calm, peace and spiritual harmony.
2. All kinds of sufferings will be eradicated of all mother sentient beings.

Objectives:

1. To promote Buddhist culture, teaching and meditation to develop compassion, solidarity, humanity, mindfulness and peace.
2. To facilitate community to practice meditation and Buddhist teachings.
3. To develop Buddhist Pilgrimage circuit among Buddha's sacred Relics in Thekchhen Pema Chholing Monastery, peripheral monasteries and Haleshi Cave.
4. To promote diverse tourism especially in Solududhkunda Municipality and in Solukhumbu district.
5. To promote economic development through hotel, local agriculture, tourist guide and tourism.

Project Description/Methodology:

Constructing a statue of Guru Rinpoche (Mahaguru Padmasambhava) is believed to bring immense benefits, wish fulfil, including peace, happiness, liberation and freedom, as well as the accomplishment of enlightenment and the establishment of the teachings. These statues act as powerful symbols of enlightened wisdom and compassion, inspiring practitioners to awaken their own Buddha-nature. Contact with holy objects like statues is thought to purify negative karma and create extensive merit for all who encounter them, It serve as focal points for devotion, meditation, and spiritual practice, guiding practitioners on their path to enlightenment. The existence of holy objects, including statues, creates the conditions for both temporary and ultimate happiness for all sentient beings.

At the heart of the project stands the grand Guru Rinpoche statue, designed with reverence and precision, symbolizing divine unity, and cosmic balance. Guru Rinpoche, also known as Padmasambhava ("Lotus-Born"), is one of the most revered figures in vjrayana Buddhism. He symbolizes many profound aspects of spiritual practice and enlightenment. The monument is oriented to face the best view of the mountains and village, reinforcing the connection between the divine and the natural world.

It emphasizes the importance of creating inclusive and contemplative spaces that welcome both pilgrims and the broader public. The integration of landscape with built form is a key consideration in this project, fostering a sense of unity between the sacred structure and its natural surroundings.

Project Scope:

After completion of this Master Plan, a Buddhist pilgrimage circuit can be developed 108 ft. Guru Rinpoche Staue, Buddha's relics in Tekchhen Pema Chholing Monastery, peripheral monasteries and Halesi Cave.

Trekking route Dudhkunda Lake, a sacred site for Hindus, Buddhists, and Kirants, viewpoints like Pattale Dada, Ratnage Dada and Pike Danda will be incorporated with Guru Rinpoche Statue.

PALYUL PEMA TSOKEY LING Project, is in the center of Solududhkunda Municipality-5 and Solukhumbu district. There is no other such big hall and facilities in this area, so the community peoples will organize celebration, Buddhist festivals, seminar, trainings, teaching and meditation.

Budget and Resource Management:

The construction work of Community, Meditation and Teaching Hall cum Boundary Wall and Entrance Gate Construction Project will be finished by 2026.

2. Secure Funding Institutions, Community and individuals as mentioned in the project proposal.
3. Guaranty experienced and qualified technical team is hired to build the statue and premises as indicated in technical plan.
4. Ensure people will participate in Buddhist teaching and meditation.
5. This newly established organization continuously monitor Buddhist pilgrimage visiting the Buddhist Circuits.
6. Ensure Buddhist teaching/training and meditation helps people to clam, peace and towards Enlightenment.

This project is in the district headquarter Sallery of Solukhumbu district. Most of the people those come to official work in Sallery and the trekkers in Sulukhumbu district especially entering to Everest region will visit here. Buddha and Guru Rinpoche not only venerated by Buddhist but also venerated by others believers.

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
